


Family of Vincenzo Cristiano & Serafina Lapetina

Vincenzo Michele Cristiano (1847-1912) Son of Vito & Angela

- Owned fruit stand in the Washington (Chippewa) Market.
- Moved to Winchester Ave. in 1893
- 1st Italians to settle in the Fillmore-Ferry area (Pine Hill Colony).
- Helped found St. Anthony of Padua Church.



3rd Generation



Vito V. Christiano (1877-1937)

Son of Vincenzo & Serafina

- Italian interpreter in the Courts.
- Mediated labor disputes.
- Elected to the Erie Co. Board of Supervisors in 1920.
- Democratic candidate for the NYS Assembly in 1932.




Angelo Christiano 'Al Rogers' (1888-1959) Augustine 'Bud' Christiano (1897-1967)

Son of Vincenzo & Serafina


- Operated fruit stand in the Washington (Chippewa)

Felix D. "Fil" Christiano (1894-1973)

Son of Vincenzo & Serafina

- Served in the American Expeditionary Forces in WWI
- Operated fruit stand in the Washington (Chippewa)
 Market & Niagara Frontier Food Terminal with brother Joseph.
- Republic Steel (1941 1955)
